

Being on St Paul's PCC

The PCC exists to support the minister in the mission and ministry of the church. So being on the PCC is about sharing in the leadership of the church. It is both a responsibility and a privilege to serve in this way.

Two Church Wardens are elected annually. Julian has faithfully been our sole Church Warden for a number of years and is willing to stand again. However, it would be great if this year we could once again be at capacity and elect **2 church wardens**.

PCC members are elected every three years. In the three-year cycle, we have 2 members standing down (who may wish to stand again), and we have two vacancies. Therefore, we will be electing **4 PCC** members. If you haven't served on the PCC before, now is the time to give it due prayer and consideration.

Please note that only members on the electoral roll of the church are able to nominate and vote in PCC and Deanery Synod elections. Parishioners and members on the electoral roll are entitled to nominate and vote for Church Wardens.
