The next steps could be broken down into three broad areas:

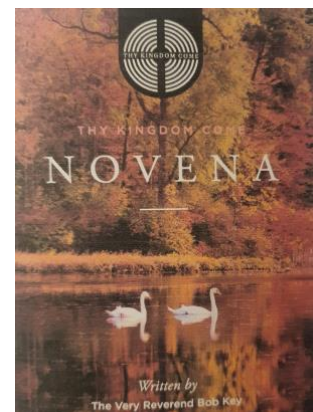
- Returning to economic stability: restoring pre-pandemic levels of income
- Continuing with light touch engagement activities, including: the jumble sales, Christmas Bazaar, summer fairs, engagement with schools, heritage open days, etc
- Applying for funding to improve the building and use of the building
