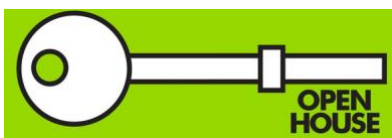
Sunday School Summer

PCC Highlights

PCC Diocesan Vision & Discussion: Mthr presented the Diocesan vision the PCC discussion focused on the 3 priorities: Discipleship, Compassionate Communities & Creative Growth during which areas for celebration and areas for development were identified. Our inclusive welcome is an area for celebration and our plan for increasing numerical growth is one that needs further development.

Post Welcome In Project Update: PCC discussed a mix of fundraising and community engagements as next steps. The PCC identified two projects for further exploration: Creating a Warm Hub in church during the winter months (something which other churches are doing). The intention would be to adapt part of the church for this purpose during winter.

Open Table Community: From brief discussions with people from other Stepney Churches who participated in Pride and from LLF process – PCC agreed to explore the possibility of joining the Open Table Network and offering a monthly LGBTQI+ service.

Coffee Morning: Explore offering a coffee morning in partnership with a local community group.

Finance: PCC noted the increase in sessional hall rentals.
